Chair Ellen L. Weintraub called the Federal Election Commission to order in an open meeting at 10:23 A.M. on Thursday, September 12, 2013 with a quorum present.

Chair Weintraub noted that Commissioner Walther was participating in today's meeting by telephone.

Chair Weintraub recognized Vice Chairman McGahn who, as a parliamentary inquiry, asked about the status of Item V, the OGC Enforcement Manual. Vice Chairman McGahn asked for a point of personal privilege to discuss the hold placed on the Manual. Discussion followed concerning the status of the Manual as well as the enforcement process.

I. CORRECTION AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Chair Weintraub recognized Vice Chairman McGahn who

III. DRAFT ADVISORY OPINION 2013-12

Service Employees International Union and Service Employees International Union Committee on Political Education by Mark Schneider, Esq.

Agenda Document No. 13-38 (Submitted Late)

Chair Weintraub recognized requestors' counsel, Mr. Mark Schneider, who was available to answer Commissioners' questions.

Chair Weintraub recognized Ms. Joanna Waldstreicher of the General Counsel's Office who presented the draft advisory opinion concerning the application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and Commission regulations to the request from the Service Employees International Union ("SEIU") and Service Employees International Union Committee on Political Education ("SEIU-COPE"). SEIU COPE receives its contributions mainly from SEIU's restricted class either by handwritten documentation or by electronic signatures provided via email or web-based communications. The requestors ask whether payroll deduction authorizations may be obtained from members of the restricted class through recorded telephone conversations subject to certain safeguards.

Mr. Schneider participated in the discussion that followed.

Chair Weintraub recognized Vice Chairman McGahn who

MOVED to approve Agenda Document No. 13-38, Draft Advisory Opinion 2013-12, and authorize the Office of General Counsel to make any technical and conforming edits.

Martin Long

Chair Weintraub recognized Ms. Joanna Waidstreicher of the General Counsei's Office who presented the draft advisory opinion concerning the application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and Commission regulations to the request from Martin Long, a candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives for Massachusetts's Fifth Congressional District in a special primary election to be held on October 15, 2013. Mr. Long has self-published a book on an issue which he describes as central to his campaign. He will receive royalties but does not plan to donate them to charity. He proposes to refer to the book in printed campaign materials

that will be paid for by his principal campaign committee and asks whether the proposed reference to the book is consistent with the Act and Commission regulations.

Discussion followed.

Chair Weintraub recognized Vice Chairman McGahn who

MOVED to approve Agenda Document No. 13-40, with respect to Draft Advisory Opinion 2013-14, and authorize technical and conforming edits.

The motion failed by a vote of 3-2 with Commissioners Hunter,

McGahn, and Petersen voting affirmatively for the motion. Commissioners

Walther and Weintraub dissented.
