SUBJECT: GUR 8175 (Straight Talk Politics)
Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement
On October 3, 2023, the Commission found reason to believe that Straight Talk Politics and Wesley Smith in his official capacity as treasurer ("Committee") violated 52 U.S.C.
$\S 30104(\mathrm{~g})(1)$ and 11 C.F.R.§ 104.4(c), provisions of the Federal Campaign Election Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act") and the Commission's regulations. ${ }^{1}$ The Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee and approved a conciliation agreement. ${ }^{2}$
