**SUBJECT:** MUR 8190 (Aníbal Comisionado 2020) (formerly AR 22-05)  
Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement

---

On December 4, 2023, the Commission found reason to believe that Aníbal Comisionado 2020 and José Luis Mendoza in his official capacity as treasurer (the “Committee”) violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a) by misstating receipts.<sup>1</sup> At that time, the Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee and approved a proposed conciliation agreement

We recommend that the Commission accept the signed conciliation agreement and close the file.
