FEC ADDS 4 "CANDIDATES"TO PRESIDENTIAL AUDIT LIST

WASHINGTON - OCTOBER 30 - The Federal Election Commission today said it would add four Presidential candidates to the special FEC audit and review schedule for the purpose of determining which candidates are eligible for federal matching funds.

The candidates, each of whom has authorized a committee to raise funds on his behalf which is filing finance reports with the Commission, are: Birch Bayh, Ronald Reagan, Milton Shapp, and Sargent Shriver.

In August, the Commission announced the beginning of the audit schedule, which included committees for nine candidates: Bentsen, Carter, President Ford, Harris, Jackson, McCarthy, Sanford, Udall, and Wallace.

The Commission said it is conducting audits of "the principal campaign committees of Presidential candidates who have either announced that they have met threshold requirements which would make them eligible to receive public funds, or on the basis of reports and statements filed with the Commission, appear to have raised substantial amounts of funds."
