WASHINGTON -- Mr. Stanley Kusper, Jr., County Clerk of Cook County, Ill., has been named to membership on the Advisory Panel of the Federal Election Commission's National Clearinghouse on Election Administration.

FEC Chairman Robert O. Tiernan said that Mr. Kusper's term will run from October 1, 1979, through September 30, 1981. "As a member of our Advisory Panel, Mr. Kusper will help advise the Commission of the best ways to use its resources to help improve the administration of elections throughout the Nation," he said.

The 22 members of the Advisory Panel are selected from among authorities in elections administration throughout the United States.

Mr. Kusper is a participating panel member of a series of five Regional Conferences and Workshops on Elections Administration being conducted by the Federal Election Commission. The first two meetings were in Madison, Wisc., and Sacramento, Calif. Other meetings will be in Philadelphia, Pa., and Austin, Texas in December, and in Winston-Salem, N.C., in January, 1980.
