WASHINGTON -- Twenty-one Presidential candidates, running under 22 independent and party listings, are on the November 4, 1980, general election ballots of the 50 states and the District of Columbia, according to a survey by the Federal Election Commission.

Only four of the candidates appear on the ballots in all of the 51 jurisdictions surveyed, with three under the same party listing in each state: Jimmy Carter, Democrat; Edward Clark, Libertarian; and Ronald Reagan, Republican. John Anderson is listed as an Independent, National Unity or Anderson Coalition candidate in different states.

Information for the survey was provided to the Federal Election Commission by individual Secretaries of State and is current through October 22, 1980.

In the 1976 Presidential elections, a total of 15 candidates were listed on the 50 State and District of Columbia ballots.

Alphabetical and state-by-state listings of the 1980 Presidential candidates follows: (The state-by-state listing does not include the four candidates who are on all of the ballot jurisdictions).
