FEC PUBLISHES PRESIDENTIAL NON-FILER

WASHINGTON — The Federal Election Commission today cited the Hall-Davis Campaign Committee for failing to file the required July quarterly report of receipts and expenditures. The report, due July 15, was to have covered all financial activity occurring during the second quarter of 1981, (April 1 through June 30, 1981.)

The Hall-Davis Campaign Committee was designated during the 1980 election cycle as the principal campaign committee of Gus Hall and Angela Davis, candidates of the Communist Party.

All Presidential campaign committees (principal campaign committees) which exceeded \$100,000 in activity were required to report monthly during the election year. In non-election years, they have the option of either continuing to report on a monthly basis, or of changing to quarterly reporting. Since the Hall-Davis Committee opted to change to a quarterly status, its reporting schedule would be to file on the 15th of April, July and October. The year-end report would be due January 31, 1982.

Reports were due by close of business on the due date unless sent by certified or registered mail, in which case, they should have been postmarked by midnight of the due date.
