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FEC CITES PRESIDENTIAL CAMPAIGNS FOR FAILURE TO DISCLOSE FINANCES

WASHINGTON - The Federal Election Commission today cited four Presidential campaign committees for failing to file the October Quarterly disclosure reports.

Those cited were:

- Brown for President (Edmund G. Brown, Jr.-D)
- Finch in the Fight President Committee Inc. (Cliff Finch - D)
- Citizens for LaRouche (Lyndon H. LaRouche - D)
- * Committee to Elect Lyndon LaRouche - (Lyndon H. LaRouche - U.S. Labor)

The reports were due October 15, and were to have covered receipt and expenditure information for July 1 through September 30, as well as year-to-date totals and itemization of certain contributor and expenditure information.

During an election year, all Presidential campaigns which raise or spend over \$100,000 must file monthly reports. In subsequent non-election years, the committees may either continue to report on a monthly basis, or change to quarterly reporting.

Monthly reports are due on the 20th of each month and contain information on the previous month's financial activities.

Quarterly reports are due on the 15th of April, July, and October, and cover information from the previous calendar quarter.

The next report for quarterly filers will be the Year End report, due January 31, 1982. Monthly filers must report on November 20 and December 20, 1981, and must file the Year End report on January 31, 1982.
