CHARLESTON SET FOR REGIONAL ELECTION CONFERENCE

WASHINGTON -- Charleston, S.C., has been selected by the Federal Election Commission as site for a 10-state Southern Regional Conference on Election Administration and Federal Campaign Financing to be held October 23-25.

Regional sponsor of the Conference is the State Election Commission of South Carolina.

States in the Southern Region are Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia.

The two-day conference is designed for elections administrators, state legislators and staff, Federal candidates, political action committees, political party workers and all others with an interest in the elections process.

In the area of election law administration, 17 workshops will discuss legislative and administrative functions required to run a well-organized, fair and open election.

Federal campaign finance issues will be discussed in 19 workshops designed for candidates, political parties, corporate and labor organizations and non-connected political committees.
