ALBANY SET FOR REGIONAL ELECTION CONFERENCE

WASHINGTON -- Albany, N.Y., has been selected by the Federal Election Commission as site for a 12-state Northeast Regional Conference on Election Administration and Federal Campaign Financing to be held September 25-27.

Regional sponsors of the conference are the State Board of Elections of New York and New York State Election Commissioners Association.

In the Northeast Region are Connecticut, Delaware, District of Columbia, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Vermont and New York.

The two-day conference is designed for elections administrators, state legislators and staff, Federal candidates, political action committees, political party workers and all others with an interest in the elections process.

In the area of election law administration, 17 workshops will discuss legislative and administrative functions required to run a well-organized, fair and open election.

Federal campaign finance issues will be discussed in 19 workshops designed for candidates, political parties, corporate and labor organizations and non-connected political committees.
