TULSA SET FOR REGIONAL ELECTION CONFERENCE

WASHINGTON — Tulsa, Oklahoma, has been selected by the Federal Election Commission as site for a Southwest Regional Conference on Election Administration and Federal Campaign Financing to be held November 13-15.

Regional sponsors of the Conference are the State Board of Election of Oklahoma and the Tulsa County Board of Elections.

Danny L. McDonald of Tulsa is Chairman of the Federal Election Commission.

In the Southwest Region are Arizona, Colorado, Kansas, Nebraska, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Puerto Rico, South Dakota, Texas, Utah, Wyoming, Virgin Islands.

The two-day conference is designed for elections administrators, state legislators and staff, Federal candidates, political action committees, political party workers and all others with an interest in the elections process.

In the area of election law administration, 17 workshops will discuss legislative and administrative functions required to run a well-organized, fair and open election.

Federal campaign finance issues will be discussed in 19 workshops designed for candidates, political parties, corporate and labor organizations and non-connected political committees.
