REGIONAL ELECTIONS CONFERENCE  
TO BE HELD IN TULSA  
NOVEMBER 13-15

WASHINGTON — Political roads will lead to Tulsa, Oklahoma, November 13-15 for a 2-day Southwest Regional Conference on Election Administration and Campaign Financing. It is one of five such meetings to be sponsored this year by the Federal Election Commission.

Regional sponsors are the Oklahoma State Election Board and the Tulsa County Election Board.

Included in the Southwest Region are Arizona, Colorado, Kansas, Nebraska, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Puerto Rico, South Dakota, Texas, Utah, Wyoming and Virgin Islands.

A total of 36 workshops and roundtable discussions have been scheduled, each designed especially for state and local elections administrators, Federal candidates, state and local political party officials, representatives from political action committees, state legislators and staff, attorneys, accountants and others involved or interested in the election process.

A series of 19 sessions will cover corporate and labor activities, federal candidates and their committees, political action committees, presidential elections, FEC enforcement, and the use of campaign finance reports.

Another series of 17 sessions will be devoted to election law and election administration, with emphasis on legislative and administrative functions to run a well-organized, fair and open election.

An introductory session will include FEC Commissioners and staff members who will explain federal campaign finance laws, review FEC publications and describe assistance available from the FEC. Other events will include two luncheons and a banquet, with programs to be announced.
