FEC CERTIFIES ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR ANDERSON'S 1980 PRIMARY CAMPAIGN

WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission has certified an additional \$44,485.65 to the 1980 primary campaign of John B. Anderson.

Based on rulings made with regard to another 1980 presidential primary campaign, the Commission held, in August of this year, that John Anderson's primary campaign had been required to repay an excessive amount to the U.S. Treasury.

Therefore, FEC auditors recalculated the campaign's financial position as of Anderson's date of ineligibility. They determined the amount of money due Anderson to be \$44,485.65. The six-member Commission voted last week to have the U.S. Treasury make additional funds available.

This brings the total received by Anderson to \$2,320,809.48 for the 1980 primary effort. His general election committee received \$4,223,611.48 after the 1980 general election.
