WASHINGTON--The names of 18 presidential candidates representing at least 17 different political parties will appear November 6 on one or more ballots throughout the 50 States and the District of Columbia, according to a compilation by the Federal Election Commission from information provided by state election offices.

Ballot access is a responsibility of the individual states. In the 1980 Presidential election, 21 candidates were on the ballot.

Candidates, in alphabetic order, their home states and parties under which they are listed on the ballots are:

JOHN B. ANDERSON, Illinois, National Unity Party of Kentucky; GERALD BAKER, Iowa, Big Deal Party; DAVID BERGLAND, Calif., Libertarian; DELMAR DENNIS, Tenn., American; EARL F. DODGE, Colo., Prohibition; GUS HALL, N. Y., Communist; GAVRIELLE HOLMES, N. Y., Workers World; LARRY HOLMES, N. Y., Workers World; SONIA JOHNSON, Va., Citizens; LYNDON H. LAROCHE, JR., Va., Independent; ARTHUR J. LOWERY, Ark., United Sovereign Citizens; MEL MASON, Calif., Socialist Workers; WALTER MONDALE, Minn., Democratic; RONALD REAGAN, Calif., Republican; BOB RICHARDS, Texas, Populist; DENNIS L. SERRETTE, N. J., Independent Alliance; GERALD WILLIS, Ala., Conservative; and ED WINN, N. Y., Workers League.

Because of individual state laws, there may be variations in party designations for some of the candidates.
