## FEC COMPILES PAC MONEY LIST

1977 - 1982

WASHINGTON -- A listing of PAC money received by U.S. Senate and House candidates over the past three election cycles has been prepared by the Federal Election Commission.

Compiled for easy reference, the information was taken from previously published FEC Reports on Financial Activity - U.S. Senate and House Campaigns for 1977-78, 1979-80, and 1981-82. Within each of the three election cycles Senate candidates are listed separately from House candidates. The candidates are listed in descending order by the amount of PAC money given to each. Where equal amounts are shown for two or more candidates, the candidates are listed in alphabetical order.

Although candidates who were not seeking election during a cycle are omitted (such as Senate candidates for past or future elections, or retiring House members), each list includes the same candidates for which the FEC has previously issued detailed financial information.
