FEC ASKS COMMENTS, SETS  
HEARING ON REVISIONS  
TO ITS SUNSHINE REGULATIONS

WASHINGTON—A public hearing on Wednesday, April 24, has been set by the Federal Election Commission to receive oral testimony regarding proposed revisions to its Sunshine Act regulations.

A Second Notice of Proposed Rulemaking also is being published in the Federal Register seeking written comments on the draft regulations. The Commission previously received comments in response to an earlier published notice. The second notice included revisions based on comments and Commission discussion of the proposed rules.

Written comments to the Second Notice must be received on or before April 11. Persons interested in testifying at the hearing must state that in their written comments addressed to Ms. Susan E. Propper, Assistant General Counsel, 1325 K Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20463.
