ELECTION AGENCY TO HOLD PAC CONFERENCE

WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission will be holding a conference on election law at George Mason University on Wednesday, October 9.

The day-long seminar will focus exclusively on trade associations and incorporated membership organizations. Workshops and roundtable discussions will provide information specifically oriented to the rules and regulations affecting those two types of groups if they choose to participate in federal elections. Topics such as fundraising, recordkeeping and reporting requirements, as well as types of communications allowed by law will be covered.

FEC Chairman John Warren McGarry and Vice-Chairman Joan D. Aikens will be two of the speakers. They will be joined by other FEC Commissioners and FEC staff.

Hosted by George Mason University, the conference will be held at the main campus, 4400 University Drive, Fairfax, Virginia, in the Student Union II Building.

Registration is \$45, which includes materials, lunch and refreshments. Limited seating is available and registration closes September 30.
