FEC SCHEDULES HEARING TO DISCUSS PROPOSED REVISIONS TO REGULATIONS

WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission has received three requests to testify at its public hearing on Wednesday, October 16, regarding proposed revisions to regulations governing limitations on contributions by persons and multicandidate political committees.

The hearing will begin at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission's fifth floor conference room, 1325 K Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.

Requests to appear at the hearing have been received from Representative Bill Frenzel (MN/03), Representative William Thomas (CA/20), and the Chamber of Commerce of the United States.

The revisions are intended to clarify the scope of the contribution limitations prescribed by the Federal Election Campaign Act by addressing several issues which have arisen since the present rules were promulgated in 1977. Information on the proposed amendments was published in the Federal Register on April 17 and May 2, 1985.
