CAMPAIGN DISCLOSURE WORKSHOP TO BE HELD IN DENVER

WASHINGTON--Colorado Secretary of State Natalie Meyer and the Federal Election Commission are co-sponsoring a one-day campaign disclosure workshop, to be held on Wednesday, November 6, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The location of the seminar will be the Governor's Court Hotel, 1776 Grant Street, in Denver.

FEC Commissioner Lee Ann Elliott and selected FEC staff will join with Secretary Meyer and her staff to present several workshops on federal and state campaign finance laws.

Following introductory remarks by Secretary of State Meyer, an overview of both federal and state laws will be presented. Additional workshops will include information on sources of funding for candidates, state and federal reporting and recordkeeping requirements, as well as FEC enforcement procedures.

The final segment of the day's activities will include a demonstration of Colorado's remote access link to the FEC's computer information base.

Registrants for the seminar include potential candidates, campaign managers, PAC representatives, political party officials, educators, attorneys, and consultants involved in political campaigns.
