CAMPAIGN FINANCE SEMINARS SCHEDULED

WASHINGTON -- Anyone interested in campaign finance law can find out anything they need or want to know about that topic at a series of regional conferences this fall.

The Federal Election Commission is co-sponsoring pre-election year campaign finance conferences with state elections officials. The FEC has tentative plans for another series of regional conferences in 1988.

Conference workshops will appeal to state and federal candidates, state and local political party officials, political action committee (PAC) representatives, attorneys, accountants, and anyone interested in campaign finance law.

Workshops will focus on candidates and their committees, political party activities in federal elections, labor and corporate PACs, non-connected PACs, contribution restrictions, reporting requirements, and other related subjects.

A special Internal Revenue Service workshop on tax issues related to federal campaigns will be part of conferences in Vermont and Texas.

Regional conferences will be held between September and November as follows:

- Burlington, VT...September 16-18
- Madison, WI.....October 15-16
- Austin, TX.....November 15-17
