CAMPAIGN FINANCE CONFERENCE SET FOR KENTUCKY

WASHINGTON -- The nation's attention will be focused on the South next month when Kentucky and many other southern states hold presidential primaries. You can prepare for Super Tuesday and the 1988 elections by attending a regional conference on campaign finance law in Louisville. Co-sponsored by the Kentucky Registry of Election Finance and the Federal Election Commission, the seminar will take place Friday, February 19, 1988, at The Galt House.

The one-day conference is designed to assist candidates, political party organizations, political action committees (PACs) and anyone interested in campaign finance law with their preparations for the upcoming '88 primaries and general elections.

U.S. Senator Wendell Ford will address seminar participants during the luncheon. Conference workshops will cover the Federal Election Campaign Act (FECA), enforcement of the FECA, federal candidate support, corporate and labor PACs, corporate and labor support beyond the PAC, non-connected PACs, political party involvement in federal elections, reporting requirements, using public records and Kentucky state campaign finance law.

Conference workshops on the federal law will be conducted by FEC Commissioners and staff members. Staff members of the Kentucky Registry of Election Finance will explain the state law's requirements. Registration begins on Thursday, February 18.
