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ELECTION COMMISSION INVITES COMMENTS ON ALLOCATION REGULATIONS

WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission has scheduled a hearing on Wednesday, December 14, 1988, for testimony concerning proposed new rules on how various groups should allocate and report funds that influence both federal and non-federal elections.

The agency is actively seeking written comments in advance of that hearing on four alternative allocation methods which are to be published under a "Notice of Proposed Rulemaking" in the Federal Register during the week of Monday, September 26. The written comments are due by November 30, 1988.

The FEC is considering these alternatives to provide greater specificity and guidance to party committees, non-connected committees and separate segregated funds (corporate and union PAC's) involved in federal and non-federal elections.
