FEC PUBLISHES REFERENCE GUIDE ON REGULATIONS

WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission has just released a new reference guide entitled, "Explanation and Justifications for Federal Election Commission Regulations." The publication is a compilation of the texts of all Explanation and Justifications for Commission regulations written since 1975, detailing their origin and intent.

A useful tool for attorneys, accountants, and others who work with the Federal Election Campaign Act, the new publication contains indexes arranged by citation and subject. This allows a reader to trace the history of specific regulations, including current, revised or deleted provisions. Texts of regulations which were never promulgated by the agency are also contained in the volume.

The compilation is designed in loose-leaf binder form so that updates may be easily inserted. Currently, the "E&J's" publication costs \$25 for 479 pages. Updates will be made available as the FEC promulgates new or revised regulations.
