## FEC SETS JUNE 28 PUBLIC HEARING OF DUPONT OBJECTIONS TO AUDIT

WASHINGTON -- A public hearing has been set for June 28 by the Federal Election Commission to hear arguments by the "Pete DuPont for President Committee" regarding the Agency's audit report of the campaign and a repayment determination.

The DuPont committee is disputing the FEC's initial determination that during the 1988 campaign it had spent \$77,447.42 in excess of the spending limit in Iowa. This would require the committee to make a \$23,254.83 repayment to the presidential check-off fund, representing the public funds utilized in the excess spending.

The public hearing will start at 10 a.m. in the FEC's hearing room. Following the Chairman's opening statement, the DuPont committee will have 30 minutes to make a presentation on the issues it raised, after which it will respond to questions posed by FEC Commissioners and Special Deputies, the General Counsel and Audit Division.
