## CONNECTICUT CAMPAIGN FAILS TO FILE PRE-CONVENTION REPORT

WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission today cited the 1990 U.S. House campaign committee of Alan R. Schlesinger, a Republican from Connecticut's 5th congressional district, with failure to file the required Pre-Convention financial disclosure report.

The disclosure report was due July 6, 1990, and should have detailed the campaign's financial activity from April 1 through June 28. If sent by certified or registered mail, the filing should have been postmarked by midnight, July 3.

On July 9, 1990, the Schlesinger Congress Committee was notified by mailgram that the FEC had not received a 12-day Pre-Convention report. The campaign had four business days from the date of the mailgram to respond. Failure to file by close-of-business on July 16 resulted in this publication. Prior notification of the required filing was sent to this committee on June 12.

Further Commission action against non-filers and late filers is decided on a case-by-case basis. Federal election law gives the FEC broad authority to initiate enforcement actions, including the imposition of civil penalties (\$5,000 for "any violation" and \$10,000 for any "knowing and willful" violation) for infractions of the law.
