CAMPAIGNS CITED FOR FAILING TO FILE DISCLOSURE REPORTS

WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission has cited the campaign committees of two U.S. House candidates for failure to file the required third quarter financial disclosure reports.

The following committees with candidates active in the general election did not file disclosure reports as of 5 p.m., October 29:

BOB ALLEN FOR CONGRESS...BOB ALLEN...REP...FLORIDA-19

HOOSIERS FOR HORVATH...JANOS HORVATH...REP...INDIANA-10

The reports were due October 15, and would have detailed each campaign's financial activity from July 1, 1990, through September 30, 1990. If sent by certified or registered mail, the filing should have been postmarked by midnight, October 15.

On October 22, both committees were notified by mailgram that the FEC had not received October Quarterly reports. The campaigns had four business days from the date of the mailgram to respond. Failure to file by October 29 resulted in this publication. Prior notification of the required filing was sent to the committees on September 21.

Further Commission action against non-filers and late filers is decided on a case-by-case basis. Federal election law gives the FEC broad authority to initiate enforcement actions, including the imposition of civil penalties (\$5,000 for "any violation" and \$10,000 for any "knowing and willful" violation) for infractions of the law.
