## FEC SETS WASHINGTON, D.C. CONFERENCES FOR CANDIDATES, PACS

WASHINGTON -- Two conferences have been announced by the Federal Election Commission designed to help Congressional candidates and those involved with political action committees better understand the law and regulations governing campaign activities.

A one-day conference for candidates for the U.S. House of Representatives and the U.S. Senate will be conducted in Washington, D.C. on Friday, April 19.

The conference will be at the Sheraton Washington Hotel starting with registration at 8 a.m. and ending at 4:45 p.m. Following a welcome address by FEC Chairman John Warren McGarry, a series of workshops will be conducted by FEC Commissioners and staff, staff from the House Committee on Standards of Official Conduct and the Senate Select Committee on Ethics, and a representative of the Internal Revenue Service.

Workshops will cover: 1) Overview of the Campaign Finance Law--for Beginners; 2) Current Trends in Enforcement Matters; 3) Reporting; 4) Other Related Laws; 5) Campaign Operations; and 6) Debt Issues.

On May 2 and 3, the FEC will hold a conference on campaign finance laws for corporations, labor organizations and trade associations. This two-day session will be at the Sheraton-Carlton Hotel in Washington, D.C. starting with registration at 8 a.m. Tuesday, May 2. Following a welcome address by FEC Chairman John Warren McGarry, the attendees will go into a series of workshops until 4:30 p.m. Workshops will resume at 9 a.m. Friday ending at noon.

Workshops will be conducted by FEC Commissioners and staff and by a representative of the Internal Revenue Service who will answer election-related questions.
