## CANDIDATE, PAC & POLITICAL PARTY COMMITTEES TO MEET IN CHICAGO FOR REGIONAL FEC CAMPAIGN FINANCE CONFERENCE

WASHINGTON -- As the 1992 federal and state elections near, the Federal Election Commission will conduct a special two-day campaign finance conference in Chicago on November 14 and 15.

This regional conference, which will be held at the Swissotel Chicago, is designed to assist candidates, political parties and political action committees (PACs) prepare for upcoming primary and general election races.

FEC Chairman John Warren McGarry, other Commissioners, a Special Deputy to the U.S. House of Representatives, and Commission staff will conduct numerous workshops on federal campaign finance rules and procedures. A representative of the Internal Revenue Service will be available to answer election-related tax questions. Rules for state candidates and PACs is the topic for a specific workshop offered on November 15 by the Illinois State Board of Elections.
