FEC TO SPONSOR PAC CONFERENCE JANUARY 27 IN PREPARATION FOR '92 ELECTIONS

WASHINGTON -- As the 1992 elections near, the Federal Election Commission will conduct a special campaign finance conference on January 27 in Washington, D.C. for nonconnected political action committees.

Designed to assist nonconnected PACs in their compliance with federal election laws, the conference will offer workshops on fundraising, candidate support, reporting, and the allocation of federal and nonfederal activity. Nonconnected PACs have no sponsoring organization such as a corporation or labor union.

FEC Chairman Joan Aikens, Vice Chairman Scott Thomas and staff will conduct the workshops, while an Internal Revenue Service representative plans to answer election-related tax questions.

The conference, which will be located at the Sheraton-Carlton at 923 16th Street, N.W., starts with opening remarks by Chairman Aikens at 8:30 a.m. The last workshop ends at 5 p.m.
