FEC ANNOUNCES EXTENDED PUBLIC HOURS DURING FILING PERIOD

WASHINGTON -- The Public Records Office of the Federal Election Commission has scheduled weekend and extended hours to accommodate press and public who want to review quarterly disclosure reports filed by candidates, PAC's and political party committees.

Campaign disclosure reports, which will cover financial activity through March 31, 1992 and which are due April 15*, will be available for inspection and copying. The Public Records Office can be contacted at (202) 219-4140.

The extended hours are as follows:

Wednesday, April 15 9 a.m. - 7 p.m.
Thursday, April 16 9 a.m. - 7 p.m.
Friday, April 17 9 a.m. - 7 p.m.
Saturday, April 18 10 a.m. - 4 p.m.
Sunday, April 19 closed
Monday, April 20 9 a.m. - 7 p.m.
Tuesday, April 21 9 a.m. - 7 p.m.

* Disclosure reports - if sent certified or registered mail - must be postmarked no later than April 15. If sent by regular mail or hand-delivered, the reports are due on April 15. Point-of-entry for House and Senate campaign committee disclosure reports is, respectively, the Clerk of the House Office or Secretary of the Senate. Those offices then forward the reports to the FEC. Presidential, PAC and party committees file their reports directly with the FEC. Presidential campaigns whose activity exceeds \$100,000 file financial disclosure reports on the 20th of each month.
