## CAMPAIGN CITED FOR FAILING TO FILE DISCLOSURE REPORT

WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission has cited a U.S. House campaign committee for failure to file a required quarterly financial disclosure report.

The following committee did not file the disclosure report as of 5 p.m., April 29:

MARGOLIN FOR CONGRESS...BURT MARGOLIN...DEM...CALIFORNIA-27

The report was due April 15, and would have detailed financial activity from January 1, 1992 through March 31, 1992. If sent by certified or registered mail, the filing should have been postmarked by midnight, April 15.

On April 22, the committee was notified by mailgram that the FEC had not received the April Quarterly report. The campaign had four business days from the date of the mailgram to respond. Failure to file by April 29 resulted in this publication. Prior notification of the required filing was sent to the committees on March 20.

Further Commission action against non-filers and late filers is decided on a case-by-case basis. Federal election law gives the FEC broad authority to initiate enforcement actions, including the imposition of civil penalties (\$5,000 for "any violation" and \$10,000 for any "knowing and willful" violation) for infractions of the law.
