## CAMPAIGN CITED FOR FAILING TO FILE DISCLOSURE REPORT

WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission has cited a presidential campaign committee for failure to file a required monthly financial disclosure report.

The following committee did not file the disclosure report as of 5 p.m., May 4:

MARROU FOR PRESIDENT ... ANDRE MARROU ... LIB ... DC

The report was due April 20, and would have detailed financial activity from March 1, 1992 through March 31, 1992. If sent by certified or registered mail, the filing should have been postmarked by midnight, April 20.

On April 27, the committee was notified by mailgram that the FEC had not received the monthly report. The campaign had four business days from the date of the mailgram to respond. Failure to file by May 4 resulted in this publication. Prior notification of the required filing was sent to the committees on March 20.

Further Commission action against non-filers and late filers is decided on a case-by-case basis. Federal election law gives the FEC broad authority to initiate enforcement actions, including the imposition of civil penalties (\$5,000 for "any violation" and \$10,000 for any "knowing and willful" violation) for infractions of the law.
