FEC SETS PUBLIC MEETING ON POSSIBLE REVISION OF CORPORATE AND UNION EXPENDITURE RULES

WASHINGTON -- A special open meeting has been set by the Federal Election Commission to consider a draft Notice of Proposed Rulemaking regarding possible revisions to its regulations on corporate and union expenditures in connection with federal elections. The public meeting will start at 10 a.m. Wednesday, June 3, in the Commission's hearing room, and will carry over to June 4, if necessary.

The proposed rulemaking is in response to a series of court decisions that began with a complaint against the Massachusetts Citizens for Life.

Although the Commission will not receive testimony from interested parties at the open meeting, public comments may be invited at a later date should a rulemaking notice be published. The draft Notice of Proposed Rulemaking will be publicly available in the FEC's Public Records Office at 2 p.m., June 1.
