FEC TO GIVE POST-ELECTION WRAP-UP ON

1992 PRESIDENTIAL CAMPAIGN FUNDRAISING & SPENDING

**New Information to Focus on Public Participation in \$1 Tax Checkoff,
Status of Presidential Election Campaign Fund, Early Warnings for 1996**

State-by-State Review of Taxpayer Participation in \$1 Checkoff to be Released

WHY: On same day that the Electoral College will meet to formally select the nation's 42nd President, the FEC will provide a comprehensive wrap-up on Presidential campaign financing in 1992 examining:

- o Taxpayer participation in the \$1 checkoff for the Presidential Election Campaign Fund in 1992 compared to each year since 1974;
- o A state-by-state review of public participation in the \$1 tax checkoff in 1992;
- o A month-by-month review of the Presidential Election Campaign Fund balance in 1992;
- o A comparison of public funds spent for the primary and general campaigns and the national party conventions, 1976 - 1992;
- o A month-by-month comparison of total matching fund payments, 1984 - 1992.
- o Matching funds paid to each presidential candidate in 1992;
- o Sources of funds received by each primary candidate month-by-month in 1992;
- o Total expenditures by each general election candidate, by month in 1992; and
- o The status of the publicly-financed Presidential Election Campaign Fund and warnings for 1996.

B-roll video will be available containing footage of tax forms being processed at an IRS office, the tax form and the \$1 checkoff question, taxpayers filling out tax forms, 1992 campaign footage, TV public service spots, and a graphic showing how checkoff funds are used. [END]
