FEC RELEASES 1992 YEAR-END PAC COUNT

WASHINGTON -- The total number of federally registered political action committees grew to 4,195, according to a semi-annual survey taken December 31, 1992, by the Federal Election Commission.

Corporate PACs remained the largest category with 1,735 committees, followed by non-connected, 1,145; trade/membership/health, 770; labor, 347; corporation without stock, 142; and cooperative, 56.

Non-connected PACs, which are not candidate or party committees, must register and report to the FEC when financial activity exceeds \$1,000 during a calendar year. Connected PACs must register when established.

Registration does not necessarily imply financial activity. For example, from January 1, 1991, through November 23, 1992, 23 percent of all PAC's reported making no independent expenditures or contributions to committees. Further financial information on PAC's is available in another FEC press release.
