SECRETARY OF STATE BABBAGE IS NAMED TO NATIONAL ELECTION ADVISORY PANEL

WASHINGTON -- Kentucky Secretary of State Bob Babbage has been named to the Advisory Panel of the National Clearinghouse on Election Administration.

The National Clearinghouse is an arm of the Federal Election Commission and the Advisory Panel is composed of 20 state and local election officials from throughout the country. The Panel advises the Clearinghouse on how best to allocate its resources in order to serve the needs of election officials. It meets annually in selected cities throughout the nation.

Prior to his taking office in 1992, Secretary Babbage served in various leadership positions, including Auditor of Public Accounts, Director of the Equine Research Foundation at the University of Kentucky, and President of Keen-Babbage Management, a financial firm. He was a co-founder of Leadership Kentucky and the Hugh O'Brian Leadership Program. He serves on the Board of Directors of the Lexington Forum and the Lexington Dream Factory.

Secretary Babbage holds an honorary Doctor of Public Administration from Campbellsville College, Master of Arts degrees from the University of Kentucky and from Lexington Theological Seminary. He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from Eastern Kentucky University.

He will attend the Advisory Panel's annual meeting March 24-26 in Savannah, Ga.
