GRANVILLE COUNTY ELECTION SUPERVISOR NAMED TO NATIONAL ELECTION ADVISORY PANEL

WASHINGTON -- Granville County Supervisor of Elections Lucinda Burnette has been named to the Advisory Panel of the National Clearinghouse on Election Administration.

The National Clearinghouse is an arm of the Federal Election Commission and the Advisory Panel is composed of 20 state and local election officials from throughout the country. The Panel advises the Clearinghouse on how best to allocate its resources in order to serve the needs of election officials. It meets annually in selected cities throughout the nation.

Mrs. Burnette has served as Supervisor of Elections of Granville County since 1984, during which time she has converted her office to a computerized records system and changed from paper ballots to optical scanners for counting votes.

She will attend the Advisory Panel's annual meeting March 24-26 in Savannah, Ga.
