CRIMINAL COURT CLERK EDWIN LOMBARD NAMED TO NATIONAL ELECTION ADVISORY PANEL

WASHINGTON -- Edwin Lombard, Clerk of the Criminal District Court, Parish of Orleans, has been named to the Advisory Panel of the National Clearinghouse on Election Administration.

The National Clearinghouse is an arm of the Federal Election Commission and the Advisory Panel is composed of 20 state and local election officials from throughout the country. The Panel advises the Clearinghouse on how best to allocate its resources in order to serve the needs of election officials. It meets annually in selected cities throughout the nation.

Mr. Lombard was first elected to the position of Clerk in 1973. He previously served as Secretary of Utilities for New Orleans. He also has been an instructor at Southern University.

A graduate of Loyola University School of Law and Tulane University, he is the recipient of a number of awards, including the Total Community Action Award for Ten Year Volunteer Service, the Pace YMCA Award for Outstanding Service and the Edna Carr Junior High School Service Award.

He will attend the Advisory Panel's annual meeting March 24-26 in Savannah, Ga.
