SAN FRANCISCO SETTING FOR CAMPAIGN FINANCE SEMINAR

WASHINGTON -- A campaign finance seminar will be conducted in San Francisco next week by the Federal Election Commission. The day-and-a-half series of workshops and discussions will be at Hotel Nikko on Thursday, September 30, and Friday, October 1.

FEC Chairman Scott Thomas, Vice-Chairman Trevor Potter, Commissioner John Warren McGarry and agency specialists will conduct workshops and respond to questions on Federal election laws to assist candidates, political party committees and corporate and labor political action committees prepare for the 1994 elections.

A workshop on the California campaign finance law will be presented by the California Fair Political Practices Commission, and a representative of the Internal Revenue Service will be available to answer election-related tax questions.
