FEC PUBLIC RECORDS OFFICE TO HOLD SPECIAL WEEKEND HOURS FOR YEAR-END REPORTING

WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission's Public Records Office will open for limited hours on Saturday, February 5, and Sunday, February 6, to make public 1993 Year-End federal campaign finance reports. Saturday hours are 10 a.m. until 4 p.m. Sunday hours are noon until 4 p.m.

In non-election years, candidate committees, and other political committees that normally file quarterly reports, file semi-annual reports. Reporting dates are set by law, with the 1993 Year-End report due by end of business on Monday, January 31. Reports sent by registered or certified mail will be considered filed on time if postmarked by midnight, January 31.

Since candidate reports must be filed with the Secretary of the Senate and Clerk of the House (who send them to the FEC), few of those reports are expected to be available until late this week or early next week. Other political committees file their reports directly with the Commission. These will be made public by the FEC as soon as possible.
