## FEC ISSUES NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING ON NATIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION ACT OF 1993

WASHINGTON -- A Notice of Proposed Rulemaking was published by the Federal Election Commission in the March 10 Federal Register. The Notice seeks public comments on specific data elements proposed for the national mail voter registration form. The Commission is required by the National Voter Registration Act to develop a national mail voter registration form for use in elections to Federal office. Comments are also requested on the information the FEC proposes to require from the states for its biennial reports to Congress under the Act.

The Commission prepared this notice after a careful review of both the comments submitted in response to the Commission's Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, published September 30, 1993, and the results of three surveys of state election officials conducted by the FEC's National Clearinghouse on Election Administration.

Written comments must be received on or before April 11, and should be addressed to Ms. Susan Propper, Assistant General Counsel, Federal Election Commission, 999 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20463.
