HALL COUNTY'S SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS NAMED TO NATIONAL ADVISORY PANEL

WASHINGTON -- Hall County Supervisor of Elections Anne Phillips has been named to the Advisory Panel of the National Clearinghouse on Elections and Administration.

The National Clearinghouse is an entity of the Federal Election Commission and the Advisory Panel is composed of 20 state and local election officials from throughout the nation. The Panel advises the Clearinghouse on methods of allocation of resources that will best serve the needs of election officials.

The Advisory Panel meets annually in selected cities. Mrs. Phillips is scheduled to attend the 1994 session in Tucson, Ariz., June 19-21, at which more than 150 state and local election officials are expected.

Mrs. Phillips was appointed Voter Registrar for Hall County in 1979. In 1981, the offices of Voter Registrar and Board of Elections were combined and Mrs. Phillips was appointed Supervisor of Elections and Chief Voter Registrar of Hall County. In 1993, she was elected President of the Voter Registrars Association of Georgia and this year received the Frances Duncan Award for outstanding achievement in voter registration by a county registrar.
