CITY/COUNTY VOTER REGISTRAR GERMAINE WONG  
NAMED TO NATIONAL ELECTION ADVISORY PANEL

WASHINGTON -- San Francisco City and County Voter Registrar Germaine Q. Wong has been named to the Advisory Panel of the National Clearinghouse on Election Administration.

The National Clearinghouse is an entity of the Federal Election Commission and the Advisory Panel is composed of 20 state and local election officials from throughout the nation. The Panel advises the Clearinghouse on methods of allocation of resources that will best serve the needs of election officials.

The Advisory Panel meets annually in selected cities. Ms. Wong is scheduled to participate in the 1994 session in Tucson, Ariz., June 19-21, at which more than 150 state and local election officials are expected to attend.

Germaine Wong has been the San Francisco Registrar of Voters since October 1988. Prior to that she served as an assistant to the city's chief administrative officer, working primarily in the area of land and housing development.
