## GOP RAISES ALMOST \$80 MILLION MORE THAN DEMOCRATS

WASHINGTON - Republican party committees continued to outraise and outspend Democratic party committees during the first 18 months of the 1993-94 election cycle, according to statistics compiled by the Federal Election Commission.

Disclosure reports filed with the FEC covering financial activity from January 1, 1993, through June 30, 1994, show that the federal accounts of Republican party committees raised \$162 million, spent \$137 million, and had cash-on-hand of just over \$21 million at the end of the second calendar quarter. Democratic party federal committees reported raising \$83 million, spending \$74 million, and had cash-on-hand of \$11 million, as of June 30.

The Democrats, although lagging behind in total dollars, increased fundraising by 34% and spending by 27% compared with the same period in 1991-92. Republican totals reflect an increase of only 3% in fundraising, while spending remained constant with 1991-92 levels.

In terms of candidate support, Democratic party committees contributed \$890,575 directly to candidates and spent \$2.2 million in coordinated expenditures on behalf of candidates. Republican party committees contributed \$707,374 to candidates and spent \$2.0 million in coordinated expenditures.

Democrats outraised and outspent Republicans in nonfederal, or "soft money" activity. In contrast to the previous election cycle, Democratic "soft money" accounts more than doubled in fundraising and spending (to \$33 million and \$30 million, respectively), while Republican nonfederal receipts decreased by 28% (to \$25 million) and spending increased only 4% (to \$25 million).

State and local committees of both major parties also reported slight increases over the previous election cycle. State and local Republican committees' receipts rose 13%,

to \$42.2 million, and spending increased by 8%, to \$32.7 million. Democratic committees' receipts increased 8%, to \$24.9 million, but spending remained the same at \$20.8 million. Increases in state and local party activity in both the '92 and '94 election cycles could be a result of changes in the FEC's rules governing the combined use of federal and nonfederal funds in federal, state and local elections.

Charts attached to this release provide summary data for the financial activities of Republican and Democratic party committees during the first 18 months of the 1993-94 election cycle compared to the same period in four previous election cycles. Comparable data on nonfederal party activity is available only for the 1991-92 cycle. The FEC began requiring national party committees to disclose their nonfederal accounts in January 1991.

\*"Soft money" describes funds raised outside the limitations and prohibitions of the Federal Election Campaign Act. Soft money must be deposited in nonfederal accounts and cannot be used in connection with a federal election. To enhance public disclosure, the FEC requires national political party committees to report the sources of receipts to all nonfederal accounts.
