MEDIA ADVISORY:

For your planning purposes, the FEC Press Office will issue two statistical releases mid-to-late week, Nov. 2-4. The first release will include financial activity of the national political party committees. The second will cover all Senate and House candidates on the November 8 ballot. The releases will contain information taken from third quarter reports, filed October 15, and pre-election reports, which were due October 27.

The availability of the statistical releases will be noted on the wire services and will be obtainable at the FEC at 999 E St., N.W.

Also available are new compilations of last-minute independent expenditures. A daily listing will be posted each day at noon in the FEC Press and Public Records offices. The information will be referenced in three ways: alphabetically by filer (persons, committees, or groups making independent expenditures); alphabetically by candidate for or against whom the expenditures have been made; and by state and district of candidates so affected. The information will be taken from 24-hour reports required to be filed for activity occurring from October 19 through November 7 and from specific schedules included in third quarter and pre-election PAC reports.

This research tool can be used in conjunction with indexes containing details of independent expenditures made in the first 18 months of the 1993-94 election cycle.

Independent expenditures are monies spent to advocate the election or defeat of a clearly identified federal candidate, which are not made in conjunction with that candidate or any agent of the candidate's campaign.
