FEC ANNOUNCES WEEKEND HOURS DURING FILING PERIODS

WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission has scheduled weekend hours for the Public Records Office to accommodate press and public seeking review of campaign disclosure reports.

The weekend hours are:

Saturday, July 15 10 a.m. - 4 p.m.
Sunday, July 16 12 p.m. - 4 p.m.
Saturday, July 29 10 a.m. - 4 p.m.
Sunday, July 30 12 p.m. - 4 p.m.

Presidential campaigns are required to file July Quarterly reports covering financial activity through June 30, 1995. The reports are due by close of business Saturday, July 15.

In non-election years, candidate committees and other political committees that normally file quarterly reports, file semiannual reports. These reports cover financial activity from January 1, 1995, through June 30, 1995. The reports are due by close of business Monday, July 31, if sent by regular mail or hand-delivered. If sent certified or registered mail, disclosure reports must be postmarked no later than midnight of the due date.

Presidential and political committees file their reports directly with the FEC. House and Senate campaigns file their reports with the Clerk of the House or Secretary of the Senate, respectively. Those offices then forward the reports to the FEC. Copies may be obtained from the Public Records office at (202) 219-4140.
