ALASKA'S LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR NAMED TO NATIONAL ELECTION ADVISORY PANEL

WASHINGTON -- Alaska Lt. Gov. Fran Ulmer has been named to the Advisory Panel of the National Clearinghouse on Election Administration.

The National Clearinghouse is an entity of the Federal Election Commission (FEC) and the Advisory Panel is composed of 20 state and local election officials from throughout the nation, nominated by the Director of the Clearinghouse and appointed by the FEC. The Panel advises the Clearinghouse on methods of allocation of resources that will best serve the needs of election officials.

Lt. Gov. Ulmer is one of four new appointees to the Panel. The others are Donetta Davidson, Arapahoe County (CO) Clerk and Recorder; Candice S. Miller, Michigan Secretary of State; and Ron Thornburgh, Kansas Secretary of State.
