Summary of Case: The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred Stand for NH PAC and Chris Marston, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to file one (1) 24-Hour Report to support three (3) independent expenditures totaling \$66,950 disclosed on the 2022 October Quarterly Report.

On February 25, 2022, the Committee filed a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) stating that there is an apparent discrepancy between the information disclosed in the FECFile database the Committee uses to file its reports and the Committee database. To date, the 24-Hour Report in question has not been filed.
