Dear Mr. Litchfield:

With regard to our phone call yesterday and the questions which were discussed, I thought it would be helpful to submit the answers in writing.

As I believe I mentioned to you, the amount of total contributions to OUR BANK's political action committee during the '84 year totals \$3,615. These funds were solicited and contributed from OUR BANK's Board of Directors, its officers and administrative staff. Although the Executive Committee of OUR BANK has not made any definite plans, we have discussed transferring the contributions from our Directors into the separate segregated fund if such a transfer is permitted. The amount of this transfer would be approximately \$2,500 to \$3,000.

After such a transaction, we plan to continue to use our state registered political action committee to facilitate contributions to state and local elections, while using our separate segregated fund to participate in federal elections.



We had approximately 48 contributions this year, with the large majority of the total contributed coming directly from our Board of Directors. We received 18 donations, each in the amount of \$150.00 from our Board.
