Dear Mr. Marinelli:

The following is in response to the questions you raised in our telephone conversation last week.

1. For the year 1993, the AMA had approximately 290,000 members. These included approximately 211,000 constituent members and 89,000 direct members. Approximately 21,000 of the direct members were also members of constituent associations. These individuals are not considered to be "constituent members" because they did not join the AMA through their constituent association. They would, however, have the same voting rights as other AMA members who are members of the constituent association, including, depending on the state, the right to vote for members of the AMA House of Delegates or for members of the State Medical Society House of Delegates who elect AMA delegates.

2. I have attached a list of PACs which are affiliated with AMPAC. It includes the PACs of the 50 state medical societies, the District of Columbia Medical Society and two county medical society PACs which do not make contributions to federal candidates but act as collecting agents for AMPAC. It does not include other county medical society PACs which contribute to state candidates.

3. The officers of the AMA Special Sections, including the delegates to the House of Delegates, are elected by representatives to the Section Business Meeting. Representatives to the Young Physicians Section Business Meeting are selected through the constituent societies. All members of the other Sections, including direct members, have the right to vote for representatives to the Business Meeting.


